1. **Interstate (cross border, from or to) need no permit.**

Airport pick up, Hotel pick up, any place pick up (and Drop off, Drive around) is OK. as long as original passengers will (or did) cross border out from NV or into NV.

(If client fly to NV, Empty Limo from CA can pick them up at airport and drive around in NV, as long as they "Will" cross border back to CA)

2. Driver have to have **Written charter order** (CA call it weigh bill, itinerary) in hand.

if not, **car will be impounded.**

3. **Name of All passengers** in written charter order.

No additional passenger other than **listed in charter order**(document).

if there is "anyone" who is not listed on document in the car ,**car will be impounded.**

Bottom line;

Enforcement officer on any place first identify himself and will check charter order(Weigh bill) for

* check if trip is interstate (To or From) transportation.

* check name(s) of passenger(s) in charter order, then ask name of each passengers. If they don't match, car will be impounded.

* if driver don't have written charter order(Date, Origin, Destination, **name of "All" passengers**), **car will be impounded.**
